11. What imagery is used to emphasize the certainty of God's judgment? ([58:9](#))
12. What reassuring words does this psalm offer the righteous? ([58:9-11](#))
13. How will the righteous react to the downfall of the wicked? ([58:10](#))
14. What will result from God's judgment on the wicked? ([58:11](#))
